## Early Years Funding

### Universal Hours

All children can access 15 hours of free education and care, over 38 weeks of the year, for all 3 and 4 years olds. Three year olds can access this funding the term after their third birthday.

Month your child is born between	They are eligible for a free place from
1 January and 31 March	Spring Term: 1 April following their 3rd birthday
1 April and 31 August	Autumn Term: 1 September following their 3rd birthday
1 September and 31 December	Summer Term: 1 January following their 3rd birthday

### Extended Hours

Some children can access an additional 15 hours of free education and care, totalling a maximum of 30 hours, over 38 weeks of the year. This is for eligible 3 and 4 year olds.

### Expanded Offer

Some children can access 30 hours of free education and care, over 38 weeks of the year from 9 months old. Parents must check their eligibility with HMRC and provide the nursery with an eligibility code.

## Eligibility Criteria for Extended Hours and Expanded Offer

Both parents must be working (or sole parent working in a lone family), and each parent earns, on average, a weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours at National Minimum Wage (NMW) or National Living Wage (NLW), AND Less than £100,000 a year.

A parent expects to earn on average to earn this amount over the coming 3 months. The eligibility process has been designed to accommodate parents with fluctuating incomes and those who are about to start working or increase their hours.

Families, where one parent does not work, will not usually be eligible for the extended and expanded entitlement EXCEPT where both parents are employed but one or both parents is temporarily away from the workplace on parental, maternity, paternity or adoption leave, or is on statutory sick pay.

The Extended hours and Expanded offer start the term after eligibility and confirmation, and not the date of application. Parents are responsible for checking eligibility with HMRC and renewing their code every 3 months. Administrative paperwork must be completed when requested by the Nursery and failure to do so may result in missed deadlines and funding not being applied for on time.
